Computer has Logos Gold and BibleWorks. Between these programs, you have all Hebrew, Greek, Aramaic, and Latin texts and Syriac NT, most of which have accompanying English translation. (These are not critical editions, however.) Both Logos and BW have tools for identifying OT/NT relations such as TSK. Both have Tov's *Parallel Hebrew/Greek*, but BW has a better implementation of it. Both have the older Charles' version of the *OT Pseudepigrapha*, but BW also has newer Charlesworth which is better.) Use BW for Apostolic Fathers, Josephus, and Philo. Logos has NagHammadi texts and also a fully searchable ANF/N&PNF.
