Practice and Review

1. I received the gifts which were sanctified and I carried them through the doors of the temple.
2. They were sitting in the prison and wishing to hear the good news.
3. Having been taught by the teacher, we are both knowing the grace of God and making it know to others.
4. Now the blind people are not able to see the things created by God, but in that day God will graciously give eyes to/for them to see.
5. (Repeatedly) Sinning against the law many times, how will we receive the life which has been prepared for us in (the) heavens?
6. Seeing the good heavens and the good land, we have believed that the world was created by God.

LXX

1 – And he went and found him sitting under an oak tree and he said to him, “Are you the person of God who has come from Judah?”

NT

1. But he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.
2. After these things, they looked, and behold a door, opened in the heavens
or ... a door that had been opened ... or ... an opened door ...
3. After she [the Syrophenician woman] went into her house, she found the child (under the circumstances of) having been thrown on the bed and the demon having gone out.
4. And it was a Sabbath in that day. Therefore the Jews were saying to the one who had been healed, “It is the Sabbath.”
5. Therefore that one answered, If a sinner he is, I do not know; one thing I know (is) that (although) I was blind, now I see.

6 – (To) the church of God which is in Corinth - having been sanctified in Christ Jesus, Grace to you and peace

7 – For by grace you have been saved through faith... For we are his *creation=poiêma*, having been created in Christ Jesus for good works.
