1 – For everyone who is asking is receiving and (everyone) who is seeking is finding and to (everyone) who is knocking it will be opened.

3 – Everyone who is believing that Jesus is the Christ has been born from God and everyone who is loving the one who begat is loving [also] the one who has been begotten from him.
(note the NRSV translation: “Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the parent loves the child.”)
