1AOR ACT	ἔ	STEM	σα/α	--	SecAct
1AOR M/D	ἔ	STEM	σα/α	--	SecMP
1AOR PASS	ἔ	STEM	θη	--	<b>SecAct</b>
2AOR ACT	ἔ	*STEM	--	ο/ε	SecAct

## Greek Verbs

### ■ 1st AORIST PASSIVE INDICATIVE

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	ἐλύθην	ἐλυθημεν
2 <sup>nd</sup>	ἐλύθης	ἐλύθητε
3 <sup>rd</sup>	ἐλύθη	ἐλύθησαν

Translate?

- I was loosened
- You were loosened...

## Greek Verbs

### ■ 1st AORIST PASSIVE INDICATIVE

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	ἐβλήθην	ἐβλήθημεν
2 <sup>nd</sup>	ἐβλήθης	ἐβλήθητε
3 <sup>rd</sup>	ἐβλήθη	ἐβλήθησαν

With the Aorist Passives, any verb that has the θη is classified as a 1<sup>st</sup> Aorist.

## Greek Verbs

### ■ 2<sup>nd</sup> AORIST PASSIVE INDICATIVE

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	ἐγράφην	ἐγράφημεν
2 <sup>nd</sup>	ἐγράφης	ἐγράφητε
3 <sup>rd</sup>	ἐγράφη	ἐγράφησαν

For now, the only 2<sup>nd</sup> Aorist Passives we know are:

γραφω > ἐγραφήν      ἀποστελλω > ἀπεσταλήν  
 -στρέφω > -στραφήν

### Greek Verbs

■ FUTURE PASSIVE INDICATIVE

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	λυθήσομαι	λυθησόμεθα
2 <sup>nd</sup>	λυθήσῃ	λυθήσεσθε
3 <sup>rd</sup>	λυθήσεται	λυθήσονται

### Greek Verbs

■ FUTURE PASSIVE INDICATIVE

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	βληθήσομαι	βληθησόμεθα
2 <sup>nd</sup>	βληθήσῃ	βληθήσεσθε
3 <sup>rd</sup>	βληθήσεται	βληθήσονται

Remember that the Future Passive is built on the Aorist Passive stem!

- PRESENT ACTIVE INFINITIVE
  - to be loosening - **λύειν**
- PRESENT MIDDLE/PASSIVE INFINITIVE
  - to be loosening myself / to keep on being loosened - **λύεσθαι**
- 1<sup>st</sup> AORIST ACTIVE INFINITIVE
  - to loosen – **λύσαι**
- 1<sup>st</sup> AORIST MIDDLE INFINITIVE
  - to loosen (for) oneself – **λύσασθαι**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> AORIST ACTIVE INFINITIVE
  - to receive – **λαβεῖν**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> AORIST MIDDLE INFINITIVE
  - to receive for myself – **λαβέσθαι**

- PRESENT INFINITIVE
  - **λύειν** – **λύεσθαι**
- 1<sup>st</sup> AORIST INFINITIVE
  - **λύσαι** – **λύσασθαι**
- 2<sup>nd</sup> AORIST INFINITIVE
  - **λαβεῖν** – **λαβέσθαι**
- AORIST PASSIVE INFINITIVE
  - **λυθῆναι** – to be loosened
  - **βληθῆναι** – to be thrown

### AORIST PASSIVE FORMS

θεραπέυω, I heal	ἔθεραπεύθην, I was healed
λύω, I loosen	ἐλύθην, I was loosened
πιστεύω, I believe	ἐπιστεύθην, I was entrusted with
πορεύομαι, I go	ἐπορεύθην, I went
ἀκούω, I hear	ἠκούσθην, I was heard
πέμπω, I send	ἐπέμφθην, I was sent

## AORIST PASSIVE FORMS

ἄγω, I lead	ἤχθην, I was led
ἀνοίγω, I open	ἠνεώχθην, I was opened
διδάσκω, I teach	ἐδιδάχθην, I was taught
κηρύσσω, I preach	ἐκηρύχθην, I was preached
βαπτίζω, I baptize	ἐβαπτίσθην, I was baptized
δοξάζω, I glorify	ἐδοξάσθην, I was glorified
ἐτοιμάζω, I prepare	ἠτοιμάσθην, I was prepared
πείθω, I persuade	ἐπεισθην, I was persuaded

## AORIST PASSIVE FORMS

ἀποκρίνομαι, I answer	ἀπεκρίθην, I answered
βάλλω, I throw	ἐβλήθην, I was thrown
ὁράω, I see	ὤφθην, I was seen, appeared
γίνομαι, I become	ἐγενήθην, I became
γινώσκω, I know	ἐγνώσθην, I was known
ἐγείρω, I raise up	ἠγέρθην, I was raised
εὕρισκω, I find	εὑρέθην, I was found
λαμβάνω, I take	ἐλήμφθην, I was taken
σώζω, I save	ἐσώθην, I was saved
φέρω, I bring	ἠνέχθην, I was brought
